

Deep Black Top Driveways That Hold Their Finish

Black top driveways look clean, but they only stay that way when the base is set right. At Jet-black.com, we see most driveway failures start with soft edges, poor drainage, and thin asphalt that breaks under tyres. A proper build starts with firm grading, tight compaction, and a mix that



matches your weather and traffic load. After paving, sealing on the right schedule keeps oils in, water out, and surface grit from chewing the binder away. Plan a quick inspection each spring, and treat oil spots with a mild cleaner, so the surface does not soften and pit.

[Black top driveways](#) also need small habits, like sweeping sand, clearing weeds early, and fixing hairline cracks before winter opens them up. If you want a finish that looks dark and even, ask for neat joints, straight lines, and careful rolling at the right heat. Done well, your

driveway feels solid underfoot, drains fast, and keeps its colour longer without constant patch work.
